393F LIGHT RECTANGULAR TABLE

Light Rectangular Table reflects Matthew Hilton's interest in the concept of 'impossible lightness,' where he tries to create the feeling of greater spaciousness in a room by reducing the visual weight of his furniture. Surprisingly slender, this sculptural table features a slim tabletop, with timber planks oriented lengthwise to proudly display the quality and natural beauty of the material, and a cantilevered leg with complex joinery.

Also available as a fixed oval table, or an extending rectangular table.



MATERIALS

TIMBER

Black walnut, white oak, or ash with a choice of a clear Danish oil, white oil, or black oil finish. White oak additionally available oxidised; ash additionally available stained or painted in a choice of 10 colours: black, white, bone, ochre, bordeaux, forest, fjord, bay, lagoon, or cove.
